

SIH40111 Certificate IV in Hairdressing

Course Description

The SIH40111 Certificate IV in Hairdressing is a qualification that reflects the role of highly skilled senior hairdressers who develop complex technical skills and knowledge working as part of or coordinating a salon team. It includes senior hairdressers who work as technical advisers with a hairdressing products company; or independently as a freelance session stylist. Functions at this level include the self-directed application of a broad range of knowledge and skills and the provision of technical leadership, training and support to colleagues. A hairdresser at this level may provide specialist services, including haircutting, hair design, hair colouring, complex colour correction, hair extensions, chemical reformation, trichology and makeup application. To achieve a Certificate IV in Hairdressing, 11 units must be completed.

Duration: 440 hours over 6 months (2 terms x 10 weeks; 22 hours per week over 3 days)

Entry Requirements: All applicants must be a minimum 18 years of age who have successfully completed Certificate III in Hairdressing or have vocational expertise (minimum 2 points out of the 3 listed below);

- experience as an operator in a commercially run salon
- provision of cutting, styling and chemical services
- establishment of a clientele base
