

Course Description

The SIH30111 Certificate III in Hairdressing is a qualification that reflects the role of individuals employed as hairdressers working as part of a team in a hairdressing environment, and who are competent in communicating in the workplace, consulting with clients, selling products and services, and designing and applying a broad range of technical hairdressing services on clients. To achieve a Certificate III in Hairdressing, 32 units must be completed.
